




#### **OVERVIEW**

Aspen Place at The Sawmill is located in Flagstaff, Arizona—the largest city in Northern Arizona, with a population of approximately 44,000. Flagstaff is also home to Northern Arizona University, which enrolls over 29,000 students.

As the primary retail and commercial hub for Northern Arizona, Flagstaff serves a broad trade area that extends nearly 150 miles north to the Arizona—Utah border, 100 miles east to Holbrook, 150 miles west to Kingman, and 55 miles south to include Sedona and Camp Verde.

In addition to its role as a regional shopping destination, Flagstaff is a key center for tourism in Northern Arizona. The city offers access to numerous national, state, and regional parks and serves as the gateway to the Grand Canyon, which draws approximately **5.5 million visitors each year**.




